





Mayflower Moving and Storage, Alexandria, Virginia, who held all corporate records of FRAZIER JAMES in storage, advised that in May or June, 1973, ETO and appeared before him and offered him \$1,000 to allow them to take the corporate records maintained in his custody. He declined their offer at this time.

On October 12, 1973, Agents of the Alexandria Office, pursuant to a Consent to Search form issued by seized 146 boxes containing records of transactions which JAMES had been involved in.

Mr. VAIRA advised while in Alexandria that ETO is a major target of his office and Grand Jury action against him was contemplated.

The following information is being transmitted to Chicago for possible rebuttal use in Grand Jury:

To date, a small portion of the records has been analyzed and one diary has been located. This diary was kept by JAMES from January 1, until April 9, 1967, and contained approximately 126 entries. It details his dealings with ETO and some of ETO's associates. Alexandria plans, unless advised to the contrary by Chicago, upon completion of their review to ship all pertinent records to the Chicago Division for analysis by the Agent assigned to ETO.

The following entry from JAMES' diary of January 5, 1967, is being submitted to Chicago for the purpose of authentication of entries in JAMES' diary. Chicago is requested to advise Alexandria as to the accuracy of any or all of the statements made:

"My last conversation with Ken Eto on Thursday, January 3, ended with K.E. going into a maniacal rage over the matter and threatening to come down here and kill me.


