

No foreign materials of value for possible association with bullets or bullet materials were found on either side of the Q64 section of windshield.

Poreign materials removed from specimens Q65 through Q70 were examined by scanning electron microscopy and X-ray analysis for particles of gunshot residue which can be produced when a firearm is discharged. No particles of gunshop residue were found on specimens Q65 through Q70. Therefore, it could not be determined if a firearm had been discharged in the vehicle from which Q65 through Q70 were removed. However, this does not preclude the possibility that a firearm was discharged and no gunshot residue particles were deposited in these areas or, if deposited, were removed by wiping or other activity before the specimens were obtained.





Immediately advise Bureau when the order is obtained and electronic surveillance is in operation. Also advise the Bureauof the code designation of electronic surveillance, when and Af an extension order is obtained, and date of discontinuance of surveillance. In addition, a succinct summary of pertinent information received from the electronic surveillance should be reported to Bureau every five days until coverage terminated.

It will be necessary to prepare a verbatim transcript of only those communications which in judgment of supervising attorney will be utilized in court in connection with this investigation. Transcripts must be prepared promptly in order that appropriate prosecutive action can be conducted which will coincide with termination of electronic surveillance coverages.

In line with existing Bureau instructions, promptly forward to Bureau each Friday, blue index cards for our special indices so as to insure we have up-to-date records of all persons whose voice has been intercepted or who are direct subjects of Title III electronic surveillance coverage.
